

March 3, 2009, Public Meeting

The second Public Meeting to take comment on the projects proposed to be included in the 2009 CDBG Application of Clarion Borough was held on Tuesday, March 3, 2009, at 6:30 at the Clarion Free Library. A list of attendees is appended to Official File Copy of these minutes.

Mr. Todd Colosimo of GCCA, the Borough's CDBG consultant, called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Mr. Colosimo stated that the projects include additional funding for prior years' projects, specifically the 2006 project-replacement of the Boundary Street steps and the 2008 project-Emerson Way improvements. In addition, if funding permits, rehabilitation of South Street from Sixth to Seventh Avenues will be included. South Street is a by-pass road between Greenville and Fifth Avenues and is heavily traveled. This project would benefit the entire Borough.
